

## **Post and Rope Pathways**

The Town has installed Post and Rope Pathways at 4 public accesses. The Division of Coastal Management has approved these pathways as an alternative to traditional wooden crossovers that are not permissible at this time. We have also placed a beach mat at the Davis Ave access. We invite you to visit one of the four locations and would appreciate your feedback on both the pathway and beach mat.

The four sites are: Queens Grant North, Rocky Mount, Davis Avenue (pictured), and Smith Avenue.

Also, CAMA has given special consideration to our situation and will allow small post and rope to be used to help navigate the steeper sections of the new dune, based on the following guidelines: posts cannot be greater than 4X4, no deeper than 5 feet, spaced no closer than 7 feet, only rope railings can be used and it must be at least 3 feet above the ground to avoid sea turtle interactions
